## **Tour Overview ~**

This adventure offers you an excellent opportunity to venture out into the ocean environment, explore some spectacular waterways and wildlife only accessible by Sea Kayak, with safe access through the Mooloolaba Seaway this is an excellent way to become accustomed to sea kayaking even if its your first time on the water!

The Sunshine Coast has a multitude of diverse and protected waterways that are ideal for the ultimate sea kayak adventure. Located a comfortable one hours drive north of Brisbane, the region is home to many spectacular marine and bird species that inhabit the coastal waters and foreshores.

Our focus for this adventure is the spectacular area between Point Cartwright across to Alexandra Headland; we paddle the Bay and enjoy the view along the coastline north to Noosa.

Relax as we take a break for a swim, snorkel and enjoy a tasty morning tea.

The coastal headlands and mangrove environments set the scene for superb wildlife viewing. We enjoy numerous sightings of turtles, pods of dolphins, fish, eagles and shore birds. One of the best ways of seeing the Sunshine Coast's hidden beauties, is by sea kayak.

This is a fantastic way to try sea kayaking in both double and single sea kayaks. All sea kayak trips are aimed at anyone with a sense of adventure not necessarily experience. This trip is ideal for anyone who needs a little time out and relaxation or simply loves being on calm, clear waters. You do need to be confident around water but paddling experience is not necessary. Your guides will show you how it's done - whether you are a complete novice or working to improve your stroke and power!

This is a great experience for first timers.

## **Tour Itinerary ~**

We depart from our pontoon at the back of the Sunshine Coast Sea Kayak Centre providing us the perfect platform to launch the sea kayaks.

You will receive full tuition before we embark covering paddling techniques, a thorough safety briefing and an introduction to the finer points of Sea Kayaking, allowing you to relax and enjoy the natural surrounds with the knowledge that your guides have it all under control.

Once on water we begin by paddling past some of Mooloolaba's most famous properties along the Mooloolah River, and then make our way out through the Mooloolaba Seaway to the exhilaration of the open sea. Here we are able to explore the open ocean in Mooloolaba Bay's safe protected waters that are sheltered by the resident Headland, Point Cartwright.

This remarkable adventure features a fully catered sumptuous morning tea an experienced guide and all associated kayaking and safety equipment.

Whilst out in Mooloolaba Bay we have the opportunity to explore the Mooloolaba bay coastline from the imposing headland of Point Cartwright through to Alexandra Headlands, best explored by sea kayak. Our kayaks allow us to experience the bay from a unique perspective. The coastline consists of white sandy beaches , massive wave cut platforms, reef bomies, and imposing rocky shoreline are all part of the adventure!

As we make our way out past Point Cartwright Headland, we are given the majestic view of Caloundra and all the Southern Sunshine Coast beaches.

We then make our way down to Alexandra Headland and follow the coastline around past the Mooloolaba Surf Life Saving Club, dolphins quite often join us here in the Bay, and the views of Mooloolaba right up to Coolum and Noosa are second to none.

On this trip, we stop in at a sheltered beach for a gourmet Morning Tea. This gives all clients the chance to swap around and try different kayaks.

On our way back through the seaway we pass the Mooloolaba Fisheries, which houses Mooloolaba's second biggest industry – Tuna Fishing.

We then make our way back to The Wharf after touring around some of the canal systems and islands which are home to the Sunshine Coast's rich and famous!

All of our Sea Kayak trips are aimed at anyone with a sense of adventure not necessarily experience. No prior paddling experience is needed.

This trip is weather dependant and trip itinerary may change. Normally, even if there is a little wind around on the day, we still are able to get out on the ocean / bay, in most conditions.

Enjoy all the sights and waterways of Mooloolaba, while the wildlife is at its best.

Come and paddle with us in the fantastic Mooloolaba Bay.

## Bookings / Reservations ~

For notice received:

1. More than 60 days before departure a full refund will be issued.
2. Between 60-30 days prior to departure an Aussie Sea Kayak Co Voucher equal to the full trip cost will be issued which is valid for 12 months and is non-transferable and non-refundable.
3. Within 29 days of tour departure: No voucher or refund.

If it becomes necessary to cancel your trip, please notify us immediately in writing (email / Letter). Upon receipt of your written advice, cancellation will take effect.

## Cancelled Tours ~

Due to the nature of operating in wilderness areas, the Aussie Sea Kayak Company reserves the right to cancel any tour prior to departure for any reason what so ever, including inadequate sign-up, which makes the trip economically unfeasible for us to operate or any logistical issues which may impede tour operations.
